**Stallion Service Contract**

This Stallion Service Contract ("Contract") is made and entered by and between \_\_\_\_\_ (hereinafter, "Mare Owner) and Lone Wolf Ranch (hereinafter, "Stallion Owner") on this \_\_\_\_\_ day of \_\_\_\_\_, 20\_\_\_\_.

Mare Owner and Stallion Owner hereby agree as follows:

1. Purchase of Breeding. Stallion Owner hereby sells and Mare Owner purchases a 2019 breeding to the following stallion: THE GENTLEMENS CLUB Registration numbers APHA 1005513 and AQHA X0700985 (hereinafter referred to as "Stallion"), which entitles Mare Owner to breed the Mare named \_\_\_\_\_ Registration Number \_\_\_\_\_ (herein referred to as "Mare") to Stallion during the 20\_\_\_\_ breeding season, subject to the terms and conditions of this agreement. The Breeding Season for THE GENTLEMENS CLUB will begin on February 15<sup>th</sup> and will end on June 1<sup>st</sup>. Mare Owner understands that the Stallion is registered AQHA Appendix, so the Mare must have regular AQHA papers (non-appendix) in order for the resulting foal to be eligible for AQHA registry. Mare Owner agrees to pay Stallion Owner a stud fee of \$1000.00 United States Dollars (USD). The total fee is due in full with the signed contract. The entire fee must be paid prior to the shipment of any semen or the live cover of the Mare. The stud fee includes breeding rights to Stallion for the current season as well as the first collection and shipment of semen. Additional fees will apply for any additional collections or shipments and mare care. Mare Owner is required to have a credit card on file to cover breeding fees.
2. Mare Information. A copy of the Mare's registration with current owner listed or a lease agreement must accompany the Contract. The recorded owner on the papers will be recorded on the stallion breeding report. If the Mare is sold or the registration is transferred, the Stallion Owner must be notified immediately.
3. Breeding Fees.
  - a. Mare Care. Mare care costs \$15 per day, wet or dry. Mare care does not include veterinary fees. Mare Owner is required to have a credit card on file with the attending veterinarian at Lone Wolf Ranch. The attending veterinarian is Link Veterinary Associates.
  - b. Shipped Semen. Shipped semen is available and shipped at \$300.00 United States Dollars per shipment (Saturday delivery will have a \$25.00 USD upcharge). The container must be returned to Lone Wolf Ranch within seven days. If the container is not returned within the timeframe, the credit card on file will be charged \$40.00 USD. A collection fee of \$175.00 USD will be charged for any semen picked up from the farm. Counter to counter is available for a \$100.00 USD upcharge. Stallion Owner does not guarantee that semen will reach the Mare Owner within 24 hours or that semen will be viable when it arrives. Stallion Owner cannot control what happens to the semen after it is picked up by FedEx. There will be no refunds granted for Breeding Fees.

4. Collection Days. Collection days are typically Monday through Friday. Collection days are subject to change based on horse shows. Please contact Stallion Owner to determine current collection days. Requests must be made by 12 noon EST the day of the shipment.
5. Live Foal Guarantee. If the Mare is barren, aborts, or fails to produce a single live foal that can stand up unassisted and nurse, Stallion Owner will allow Mare Owner a return breeding privilege of the Mare to the Stallion provided that Mare Owner furnishes Proper Notification. Proper Notification will be defined as follows: written certification by a licensed veterinarian within seven days that the mare has slipped or produced a non-viable foal.
6. Registration. Mare Owner will be solely responsible for seeking registration of the resulting foal in the appropriate breed registry or registries and will pay all associated fees or expenses.
7. Substitute Mare/Stallion and Refund Policy. In the event of the death or incapacity of the Mare, Mare Owner shall be allowed to breed a substitute Mare to the Stallion, provided that the Stallion Owner has given advance approval in writing of the proposed substitute Mare. A new Contract must be completed and returned to the Stallion Owner for the substitute Mare. No refunds shall be permitted. In the event of the Stallion's death or unfitness for breeding before the Mare is confirmed in foal, Stallion Owner shall have no liability to mare owner except to notify Mare Owner. No refunds shall be given.
8. Breeder's Certificate. The Breeder's Certificate will be issued to the Mare Owner once a live foal has been produced and all outstanding charges are paid.
